This is a Texas issue. There are more than 900 planned in Texas Alone. There are Major concerns as far as safety. Did you see that coming?

Expanding further, one will find that Senator Marco Rubio and 26 other legislators signed a letter of concern for national security when alerted that China was accessing the software remotely at Lake Lejune Military Base. Leading to these builds to be removed from military bases.

Furthermore, when these batteries go into Runaway, they emit Toxic Gases and Pollute heavy metals into all surrounding environments. Such as found from Moss Landing in Monterey Bay, California.

One in particular, that has 600 acres and 300 head of cattle. Also on his property is Lacy Fork Watershed which connects to Cedar Creek Lake nearby. This lake is not only a great profit to the smaller cities/counties during tourism season; it is also the primary water source for Tarrant and Fort Worth County. One of the things learned from Moss Landing was toxic pollution at least up to 2 miles out .
